School of Medicine's history dates back to 1894 when it was founded during the reign of Abdülhamid II under the name Mekteb-i Tıbbiye-i Şahane and throughout its history, it continued to offer education under different institutional names and in 1983, it joined Marmara University. Medium of instruction is in English and there are 3 departments.

The School moved from its historical building, Haydarpaşa Campus, to new modern campus in Maltepe, Recep Tayyip Erdoğan Campus where preclinical part of education programmes are conducted. This building contains modern well-equipped multi-purpose research labs (anatomy, biophysics, medical biochemistry, physiology, microbiology, medical biology and immunology) and smart classrooms. There are two hospitals with a capacity of 1200 beds. These hospitals allow the students to have clinical experience. There are forty-three departments.

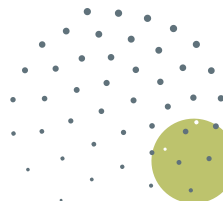

Later, the school was merged with the Anadolu Hisarı Youth and Sports Academy in 1975 and both of them were attached to the ministry of Youth and Sports. These two institutions were merged with the Ataturk Education Faculty under the name of the Department of Physical Education and Sports in 1982. The department became the Physical Education and Sports School in 1992. Consequently, the school took its current name as Faculty of Sport Sciences in 2016.
